PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The coffee tables feature a four-legged frame of polished aluminium and a hovering tabletop of marble. Available in two sizes and with two different marble variants, the mix of organic stoneware contrasts the hardness of the frame. The coffee tables can be displayed in solitary or paired for a complete coffee table composition. Use the smaller coffee table as a side table for either the Vipp610 Loft sofa or the Vipp632 Chimney sofa.

KEY SELLING POINTS

The frame of the Vipp coffee tables is made from polished aluminium, which is passivated to strengthen the surface.

All screw connections are hidden under the tabletop.

The frames are manufactured to be shipped in a disassembled state to optimize space during shipping with the intention to minimize transport emissions. Customers can easily assemble the frame using the 4 screws included in the packaging.

Vipp426:

The Sky grey bush hammered marble presents a rough surface for a refined and tactile appearance. As a natural stone, each piece of marble is unique with distinguished marks, veins, spots etc. We call it beauty marks.

Vipp427:

The Ocean grey marble is a dolomite, which is a hard and resistant marble variant. As the Vipp Ocean grey tabletop is made from natural stone, no two pieces are the same. Each marble top has a unique visual expression.

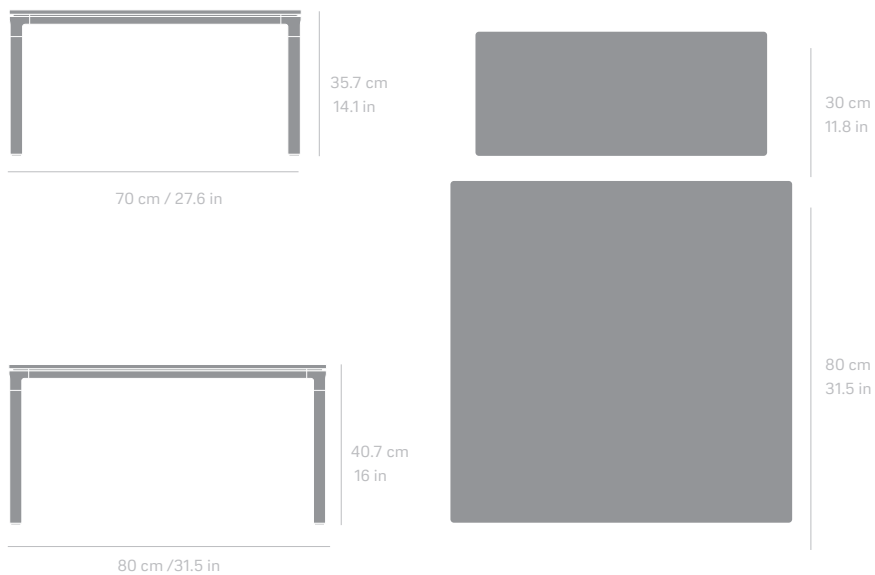

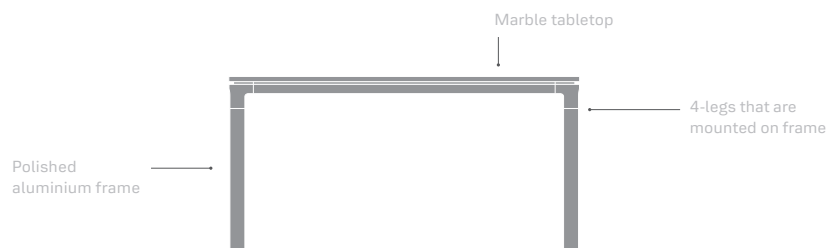

PRODUCT MATERIALS
 & SURFACE TREATMENT

Sky grey bush hammered marble

The grey stone has a lot of unique details, like white veins, red marks from iron and minerals, as well as lighter or darker "dust/sprinkles". The stone has shades of grey varying from almost white to dark grey. Fossils and other natural marks are often seen which gives the stone a nice play of colours.

Finish

Bush hammered meaning lots of white spots and intended dents in the surface sealed with natural impregnation slightly enhancing the color yet leaving a protected surface. The marble is hammered to break the top layer of the stone, creating a less uniform surface with small pockets and gaps, making each tabletop very distinctive.

Ocean grey marble

The grey stone is a dolomite which is a hard and resistant marble. Vipp Ocean grey is a type of limestone which is compacted over millions of years, leaving a lot of details, like white veins, red marks from iron and minerals, glass veins, and long 'cracks' from ancient earthquakes which are filled with resin. The stone has shades of grey varying from light grey to dark grey. Fossils and other natural marks are often seen which gives the stone a nice play

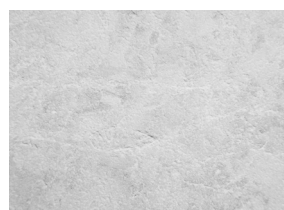
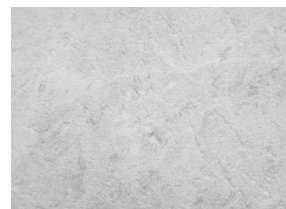
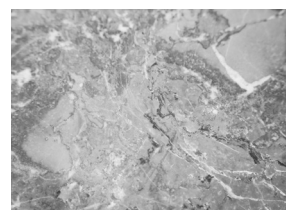
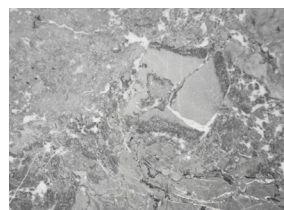
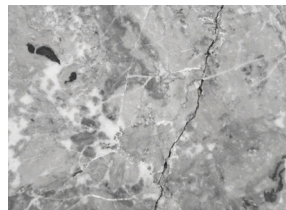
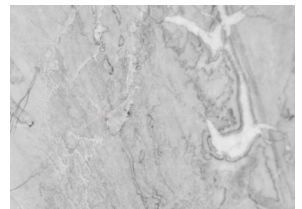
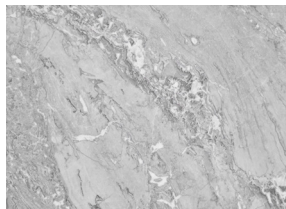
Finish

Honed (matte) and sealed with natural impregnation slightly enhancing the color, yet leaving a protected and matte surface.

Frame and legs

The four-legged frame is made from polished and passivated aluminium. The surface is susceptible for scratches, wear, and tear, which is to be considered as patina.

The polished finish should not be mistaken for a mirror-finish. True to the material, brushing and polishing lines will be visible on the product from certain angles.

PRODUCT CHARACTERISTICS
& MAINTENANCE

Characteristics

Marble stone is a natural material, and each marble plate is inimitable. Varied visual expressions of the marble are to be expected.

Marble

Gentle, regular cleaning is recommended. Dust off the surface regularly and wipe down the marble with a damp cloth when needed. If necessary, add a mild, acid-free detergent. Remove the detergent with a clean damp cloth. Marble is limestone and does not tolerate any kind of acid (juice, wine, ketchup etc.) Marble is sensitive and should be treated cautiously. Always use coasters for drinking glasses and rivets for hot items to keep your table beautiful and free from marks and stains.

Stain removal

Remove the stain immediately using a lint-free cleaning cloth with warm water and a mild detergent. Avoid using dusting sprays or abrasive cleaners. In case of serious damage contact a professional polisher.

Polished aluminium surfaces

Keep surfaces clean and dry. No acidic or abrasive cleaning agents can be used. Clean using a glass cleaning agent and polish with a dry clean cloth to remove any marks and residue from the cleaning agent.
